Safeguarding Co-ordinator

- 1. Ensure the Club is run and managed in accordance with its constitution
- 2. Manage and report concerns about children and vulnerable adults and put into place procedures to safeguard children, young people, and vulnerable adults in the club.
- 3. Assist the club in fulfilling its responsibilities to safeguard children, young people, and vulnerable adults.
- 4. To be the first point of contact for members, volunteers, parents, and children/young people where concerns about children's or vulnerable adults' welfare, poor practice, or child abuse are identified
- 5. To be the first point of contact with the Archery GB Safeguarding Team, as required.
- 6. Implement Archery GB's reporting and recording procedures.
- 7. Ensure and facilitate the process for DBS checks to be carried out for all Club officials that require such checks.
- 8. In the event of any incident being reported deal with the matter in accordance with current Archery GB guidelines.
- 9. Maintain contact details for local Social Services, Police, and the Area Child Protection Committee.
- Maintain a Club safeguarding policy that is fully compliant with current Archery GB guidelines
